EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Portables in Need of Replacement

Our grade 3-5 modular classroom building is nearly 30 years old. The cost of repairs continues to escalate as we patch up a deteriorating portable that is 10-20 years past the end of its lifespan. More than 150 students use the 7,889 sq. ft. (733 sq. m.) building.

Bare Believe

Interior issues

- 5 forced air furnaces often break down
- · Floor tiles lifting; holes in ground
- Bathroom stalls becoming unstable
- Mice are ongoing issue

Exterior issues

- Underground drainage continues to plug (no access)
- · Soffits & fascia damaged by drainage overflow
- Siding becoming loose and warped
- Wood core rotting in exterior metal doors

\$ 6,000 - Drainage & furnace repairs


