WHY TEACH AT NCS

1. Student Centered Approach to Learning

At NCS, we don't just say we believe that God has made all kids unique. We live that out! We do not offer a 'one size fits all" education, rather, we provide cross-graded, cross-curricular, multi-age learning experiences that challenge and engage students where they are at and acknowledge who God has created them to be.

2. Collaborative Teaching Teams

Life is more fun together, and so is teaching. Each week teachers have 3 hours of collaborative planning time with their teams. They plan, create, discuss, modify, adapt and laugh together, When the workload is shared between teachers, students don't fall through the cracks and it creates a shared responsibility for all students.
